RULES FOR PROVISION OF ALCOHOL ON CHURCH PREMISES

The following rules apply to all Hirers of the premises and are framed in order to comply with the Premises Licence held.

Responsibility

• The organisers must appoint two people who are responsible during the event for ensuring the compliance with these rules.

Supply of Alcohol

- Alcohol (wine & beer) may be supplied as part of the ticket price. No Spirits.
- Sale or provision of alcohol as part of a fund raising event is also permitted
- Alcohol can only be served or provided to an invited person or someone who has purchased a ticket for the event.

Permitted areas for the serving and consumption of alcohol

- Bradbury Hall Complex including coffee bar
- Church Rear foyer area only
- Church House Leonard Hall, Cranbrook Room (Parlour) and Kitchen
- No alcohol to be consumed or provided in any other meeting rooms or the main body of the Church
- No alcohol or food may be taken off the premises and consumed outside on Church property

Child Protection

- The supply or sale of alcohol to anyone under 18 years of age is against the law and is strictly forbidden
- Any person under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an Adult

Permitted times for provision/consumption of alcohol

- No alcohol can be served or consumed before 10.30am
- The consumption of alcohol must cease by 10.45pm Monday to Saturday and by 10.15pm on Sundays. This to ensure that everything is cleared away before the premises are vacated by 11.00pm Monday to Saturdays and 10.30pm Sundays.

Safety

No glasses or bottles may be taken on to a Dance Floor or a Performance Space.
